The field test — which will occur from November 2018 to February 2019 — will be administered online at your school and will cover math and English language arts. Schools may elect to administer either or both subject areas to students in grades 4–12. Each school determines the grade and subject area combinations to be tested. Each test will take between 45 and 50 minutes (5 minutes of administration time and 40–45 minutes of testing time).
