## Year Start

## Year End

## First Semester

Mrs. Jones guides her students along learning progressions using **Formative resources** on a day-to-day basis. Periodic end-of-unit **Testlets** show her student, Kyle, and his parents steps he can take to improve.



## Second Semester

More end-of-unit **Testlets** and regular use of **Formative resources** give Mrs. Jones real-time insights on how she can adjust instruction to suit her students' needs.
